Dear Parent/Carer

After a successful term of delivering an additional Period 6 intervention with our Year 11 cohort, we are now providing this opportunity for other year groups.

Each department has been allocated an evening with each year group so that class teachers can provide small group or individual interventions for students that need additional input to support their progress. This is not a detention; these sessions are interventions that aim to help students achieve their targets. Even students that consistently work hard may be asked to attend if their teacher feels that they need further explanation to understand a skill/topic or address a misconception.

Class teachers will request student attendance to these sessions by Thursday of the previous week and students will be informed by their form tutors during Friday registration. As this is a bespoke, personalised intervention, based on the individual needs of students, there will not be a set pattern of when or how regularly your child will be expected to attend. Please discuss with your child and ask them to take responsibility for informing you if they have been requested to attend a session.

Sessions will run from 2:45pm to 3:45pm each evening, but your child may not always have to attend for the full session. **If you require your child to be supervised in school until 3:45pm, please write a note in their planner or let their student manger know.**

Students will be given more information about this, but it is an expectation that they attend.
